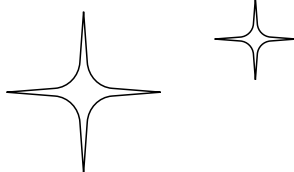
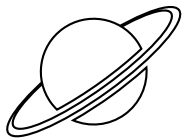
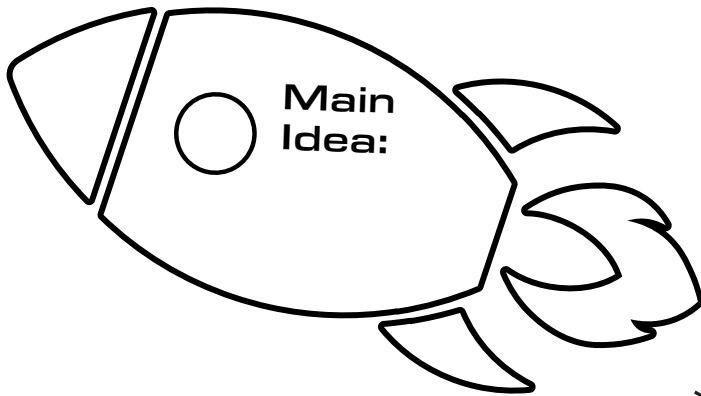




Read the paragraph about renewable resources below. Determine the main ideas and identify three supporting details. Check with a friend to make sure you got it right!
